Course Description:

Participants will learn how to become active citizens who are aware of and grateful for their liberties and rights. They will understand the need to participate in their government and protect their freedom, helping to defend their country and standing up for individual rights on behalf of all its citizens. Learn how your local community functions and how you can interact with local government to potentially make positive change.

Below is information you'll find valuable in helping you prepare for the class:

- Be sure your child picks up a syllabus from the instructor on the first day of class and reviews the syllabus with parents/guardians.
- Most of the merit badge requirements and course information are covered and discussed in class, however we do also assign homework for certain classes.
- Guardians MUST check in with the NSB instructor on the first day of class to ensure proper reception of child in class. Families may check in at the pedestal directory/site map at the Building C staircase or visit the NSB office upstairs.
- Scouts MUST WEAR CLOSED TOED SHOES AT ALL TIME. No sandals, Crocs, or roller shoes are permitted.
- Electronics and other valued items should be left at HOME.
- Scouts can carry their belongings with them to class; Sea Base is not responsible for any damaged or lost items.
- Snacks and drinks are recommended if your child is participating at NSB for an extended period
 of time.
- Scouts are not permitted to leave the Sea Base without a parent/guardian.
- · Scouts should label all personal belongings.
- Scouts must bring blue cards on the last day of class. Instructors will not hold blue cards for students before the last day of class.
- Some classes will include a free pontoon/whaler boat field trip in which Sea Base provides life
 vests for all campers. Life vests MUST be worn on docks and boats! Campers should bring sun
 block and extra drinking water especially if their class involves being out in the sun.
